Through the SPOC hotline and Web site, we provide a range of resources for health care providers and patients who are uninsured or have reimbursement issues:

Single Point of Contact (SPOC) provides reimbursement information and assistance for patients so that they can focus on treatment. Patients and their caregivers should contact SPOC if they are experiencing difficulties with access to Genentech's products for financial reasons.

The Genentech® Access to Care Foundation helps eligible patients* gain access to Genentech products. From 2000 through 2004, Genentech donated drugs with a market value of \$208 million through this Foundation.

*Eligible patients are patients who meet specific medical and financial criteria and who are uninsured or rendered uninsured due to payer denial.
